Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors (the "Board") of the above captioned District will hold a regular public meeting at 323 E. Louetta Road, Spring, Harris County, Texas 77373, said address being an official meeting place of the District.

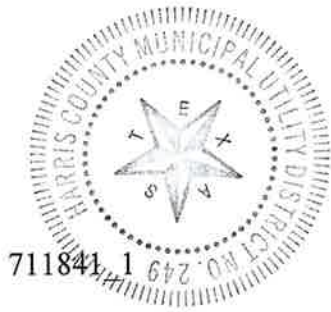
**The meeting will be held on Thursday, March 21, 2024, at 6:30 p.m.**

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action necessary and appropriate with respect to such matters:

1. Public comments;
2. Approval of the minutes of the February 15, 2024, Board meeting;
3. District security matters;
4. Tax Assessor-Collector's Report, including authorizing the payment of invoices presented;
5. Delinquent Tax Report, including discussion of any legal action taken by the District's delinquent tax collections attorney;
6. Bookkeeper's Report, including financial and investment reports, and authorizing the payment of invoices presented;
7. Authorize consultant to research unclaimed property and consider authorizing bookkeeper to prepare Unclaimed Property Report as of March 1, 2024;
8. Discussion regarding landscaping and maintenance within the District;
9. Storm Water Management Program Report;
10. Engineer's Report, including:
  - a. Authorizing the design and/or advertisement for bids for the construction of facilities within the District, and approving of related storm water plans, including:
    - i. Review and approval of any Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plans or Storm Water Quality Management Plans related to construction within or on behalf of District, and the execution of any documentation in connection therewith;
    - (ii) Water Well No. 2;
    - (iii) Wastewater Treatment Plant Bar Screen Improvements; and
    - (iv) Wastewater Treatment Plant Permanent Restroom Facilities;

- b. Authorizing the award of construction contracts or concurrence of award of contracts for the construction of facilities within the District, approval of any related storm water permits and acceptance of TEC Form 1295;
  - c. Status of construction of facilities to serve land within the District, including the approval of any pay estimates and/or change orders;
  - d. Status of Storm Water Quality Permits, and the taking of any action in connection therewith; and
  - e. Consideration of proposed regional detention project with Harris County Water Control and Improvement District No. 110;
11. Authorize annual submission to each electric utility that provides transmission and distribution service to the District and each retail provider for determination of District facilities that qualify for critical load status relative to compliance with Section 13.1396, Texas Water Code;
  12. Discussion regarding utility capacity requests, including request from Spring Volunteer Fire Department in connection with the development and possible annexation of a 50-acre tract of land;
  13. Operator's Report, including:
    - a. Monthly Report;
    - b. Appeals of District charges;
    - c. Status of compliance with District's waste discharge permit;
    - d. Authorizing the repair and maintenance of District facilities, and the taking of any action in connection therewith;
    - e. Refer accounts for collection;
    - f. Status of fire hydrant repairs; and
    - g. Status of repairs pursuant to recent District and Facilities Evaluation report;
  14. Status of review of District's Drought Contingency Plan, and any recommended updates to same;
  15. Amendment to the District's Rate Order in connection with, but not limited to, annual rate increase from Best Trash for solid waste collection services;
  16. Communications Report/Website updates, including status of District Information Sheet;
  17. Attorney's report;
  18. Closed Session pursuant to Texas Government Code, Section 551.071 (consultation with attorney regarding matters protected by attorney-client privilege) and/or Section 551.072 (deliberation regarding acquisition of interest in real property);
  19. Reconvene in Open Session and authorize any action(s) necessary in connection with matters addressed in closed session; and

20. Matters for possible placement on future agendas.
